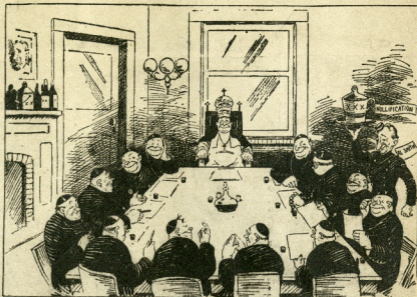


Cabinet Meeting - If Al Were President
